The content and focus of the Study Centre: it is regularly expanded.

The content is focussed on British, European and World (including USA) History in the nineteenth and twentieth centuries. More recent added content has an emphasis on the twentieth century.

Navigation throughout the Study Centre is easy, facilitated by links at the base of most pages.

The Study Centre

- ◆ eLearning. Resources for virtual learning environments (VLEs). A few AS or A2 unit e-guides
- ◆ AS/A2 resources in the Study Centre integrated and arranged in eight topic areas.
 - British History, nineteenth century. British History, twentieth century
 - German History, nineteenth century. German History, twentieth century
 - Russian History, nineteenth century. Russian History, twentieth century
 - Italian History, nineteenth and twentieth centuries. General and World (inc USA) History
- ◆ *e-new perspective*. The whole journal online edition, in printable pdf.
 - Starts with Vol I - the current volume. Some 240 topic articles. †
- ◆ Indexes and access to *new perspective* articles by topic **AND** by volume. Some 240 topic articles. †
- ◆ Exam answers and study advice for AS and A2 students.
 - Advice on answering document questions: 25 articles†
 - Advice on answering structured and period study questions: 26 articles † and other study advice.
- ◆ Core concepts, terms and ideologies - 33 of them. In addition, questions and answers on each that can be run in parallel windows (to foster digestion) and an article on concepts and their importance.
- ◆ Factual frameworks - key events by studied topic. Currently 7 indepth chronologies - more to be added. †
- ◆ Topic guides for AS and A2 Modern History - the complete list of 25 topics.
- ◆ Selected links to Internet History sites. This section partly superceded by skillful search engine use.
- ◆ *The Good History Students' Handbook*. The online edition of a 1990s, 173 pages, bestseller. (html format)
- ◆ The Individual Study and research - advice by authors for individual research (forthcoming).
